PROHIBITING THE PRESENCE OF CHILDREN UNATTENDED UPON THE STREETS,
LANES, ALLEYS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, PENN-
SYLVANIA, BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS, DESIGNATING WHO SHALL BE RESPONSIB-
BLE FOR THEIR PRESENCE THERE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED By the Town Council and Cheif
Burgess of the Borough of Bentleyville, and it is hereby ordained
and enacted by authority of the same:-

SECTION I. That from and after Jan 1st, 1912,
it shall be unlawful for any child under the age of fourteen
years to be upon any of the streets, lanes, alleys, highways or public
places in said Borough, after eight o'clock P. M. from September
(1st) first to May (1) first, and after 9:30 o'clock, from May
(1st) first to September (1st) first, unless accompanied by his or
her parents or Guardian, or some adult member of his or her family.

SECTION II. That it shall be unlawful for the parents of such
child, or the person or persons for the time being in charge of such
child to permit such child to be upon the streets, lanes, alleys,
highways or public places of the said Borough, at the times hereinabove
set forth, and such person or persons shall be held responsible for any
violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION III. That any parent of such child or children, or the person or persons for the time being in charge thereof, shall, upon permitting any such child or children, under the age aforesaid, to be upon the streets, lanes, alleys, highways or public places of the Borough, within the times hereinabove designated, be deemed guilty of a violation of the provisions of this ordinance, and upon conviction thereof before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the said Borough, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding Two (2) Dollars, and the costs of prosecution, for each offense, and on default of the payment of such fine and costs, be subject to imprisonment, for a period not exceeding forty-eight (48) hours.

SECTION IV. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance, be, and the same are hereby, repealed, in so far as the same conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
