

ORDINANCE NO. 186

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, PROHIBITING DUMPING, STORAGE OR ACCUMULATION OF JUNK OR ABANDONED OR JUNKED AUTOMOBILES ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHIN THE BOROUGH ; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

Section 1. The dumping, storage or accumulation of junk or abandoned or junked automobiles on public or private property within the Borough is hereby declared a nuisance and prohibited as herein provided.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to dump, store or accumulate junk or abandoned or junked automobiles on private or public property within the Borough.

Section 3. For the purposes of this Ordinance, "junked automobiles" is defined as any automobiles stored for re-sale as junk metal or for the selling of parts therefrom.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 and in default of payment thereof shall be committed to the Washington County Jail, for a period of not more than thirty (30) days for each separate offense with the right of appeal as in other cases of summary conviction.
