ORDINANCE NO. 323

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 155 of 1950, REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, WASH-INGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA; AND PROVIDING FOR PARKING METER FEES, AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, AND IT IS HEREBY SO ORDAINED AND ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That after the effective date hereof the following sections of Ordinance No. 155 of 1950, be amended to read as follows:

SECTION I (b): The West side of Main from the intersection of Main Street and Washington Street, to the property line of the Texaco Station

SECTION II (a): On either side of Main Street from the parking lot adjacent to the Sokol Club Building to the building of the VFW Club.

SECTION II: (d): The West side of Main Street from the southern crossing of the Pennsylvania Railroad to the intersection of Main Street and Washington Street.

That in order that the Police Officers may properly compute the time during which a vehicle is parked, the owner or operator of said vehicle shall, upon entering such parking space during the time of limited parking, immediately deposit a coin, or combinations of coins of the United States of America in the parking meter situated to serve said parking space, and operate same in accordance with the instructions therefore. Failure to do so shall constitute a violation of this ordinance. Upon the deposit of five-cent or ten-cent coin, and placing the meter in operation, the parking space may be lawfully occupied by such vehicle during the period of parking time which has been prescribed for the particular amount deposited. The parking meters, when installed and properly operated shall be so adjusted that five-cent coins may be deposited, permitting the vehicle to be parked for a period of 30 minutes; each ten-cent coin permitting the vehicle to be parked for a period of 60 minutes. If such vehicle shall remain parked in any such parking space after the lawful parking period has expired, such vehicle shall be considered as parking overtime, and the parking of a vehicle overtime shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION VIII (a): Such owner or operator may, within thirty. (30) minutes of the time of said notice, pay at police headquarters as penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation, the sum of fifty-(\$.50) cents.
