

ORDINANCE NO. 564 of 2014

**Bentleyville Borough
Washington County, Pennsylvania**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A POLICE DEPARTMENT IN AND FOR BENTLEYVILLE BOROUGH, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA; CREATING THE OFFICES OF CHIEF OF POLICE, PATROL-MAN, AND SPECIAL SCHOOL POLICE; PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF APPOINTMENT; DESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF EACH OFFICE; AND MAKING OTHER PROVISIONS AND REGULATIONS RELEVANT THERETO.

WHEREAS, Bentleyville Borough has recently utilized the services of the Southwestern Police; and

WHEREAS, Bentleyville Borough believes it to be in the best interest of Bentleyville Borough to establish a new police department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of Bentleyville Borough pursuant to the Borough Code, as amended, as follows:

Section One: Title

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Bentleyville Borough Police Department Ordinance of 2014".

Section Two: Establishment of Police Department

A police department is hereby established in and for Bentleyville Borough, Washington County, Pennsylvania. The Chief of Police shall be the chief executive of the Police Department. He shall under the direction of the Mayor, be in charge of the Police Force and have supervision over its members in the exercise of their powers, duties and authority.

Section Three: Officers

Subordinate to the Chief of Police, in the following classifications are hereby established, the Police Department/Patrolman, and such additional classifications to Bentleyville Borough shall at any specific time have appointed one or more police officers. The order of authority among such subordinate classifications shall be in the order above listed. The number of persons to serve in each of such subordinate classifications on a full time and/or part time basis, and the compensation of each shall be as determined by Bentleyville Borough Council from time to time.

Section Four: Severability

If a section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section Five: Repealer

Any Ordinance containing any provision inconsistent herewith to the extent that such provision is inconsistent, that provision is also hereby repealed.


Section Six: Effective Date


