A N O R D I N A N C E

RELATING TO THE EXHIBITION OF PLAYS, SHOWS, MOUNTEBANKS, JUGGLERS, AND OTHER EXHIBITIONS, IN THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

SECTION III. For each exhibition of a play, the sum of Three (\$3) Dollars.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED By the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I. That from and after the adoption and approval of this ordinance, it shall not be lawful for any person, firm or corporation to exhibit any play or show within the limits of the Borough of Bentleyville, or shall it be lawful for any mountebank or juggler to give any exhibition, slight of hand performance, or other show or entertainment within the limits of said Borough, without first obtaining a license so to do, as hereinafter provided.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to give any of the exhibitions mentioned in Section I hereof, within the limits of said Borough, shall first pay to the Treasurer of said Borough the license fee prescribed by the Third Section hereof, for which fee the said Treasurer shall give a receipt, which receipt shall be presented to the Burgess, who shall issue a license for such exhibition, retaining the said receipt, except that in the event the said Burgess should determine upon investigation that the show, exhibition, or other performance, is of a lewd or immoral character, and will tend to debauch the morals or interfere with the good order in the said Borough, he may



then refuse to issue the said license and return the receipt to the holder thereof, and upon the return of such receipt to the Treasurer, the license fee so paid shall be refunded.

SECTION III. For each exhibition of a play, the sum of Three (3) Dollars.

For each exhibition of a show, circus, or side-show, the sum of Twenty-five (25) Dollars.

For each exhibition of amountebank, the sum of Five (5) Dollars.

For each exhibition of a juggler, slight of hand or trick performer, the sum of Five (5) Dollars.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall not apply to plays or shows given strictly for a charitable, educational or religious purpose.

SECTION V. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the payment of a fine of not less than Five (5) Dollars nor more than Fifty (50) Dollars, for each and every offense, and in default of the payment of the fine so imposed, shall be subject to imprisonment, as provided by the ordinances of the said Borough regulating summary convictions.

SECTION VI. That ordinance No. 8 of the said Borough, adopted Sept 5<sup>th</sup> 1910, and approved Sept 19 - 1910, be and the same is hereby repealed, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, in so far as the same conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
