

ORDINANCE NO. 256 OF 1971

AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING ORDINANCE NO. 248 of 1970, LEVYING AND FIXING A TAX ON ALL OCCUPATIONS OF PERSONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 1971.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, in pursuance of authority granted to Boroughs by Act No. 511 of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania, approved the 31st of December, 1965 A.D.

SECTION I

Ordinance No. 248 of 1970 providing for the levy and collection of a tax for general borough purposes on all occupations of persons within the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, is hereby re-enacted and continued and the same tax of twenty (20) mills is hereby levied, assessed and imposed for the calendar and taxing year beginning January 1, 1971 and continuing until December 31, 1971.
