

ORDINANCE NO. 247 of 1970

AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING ORDINANCE NO. 241 of 1969 IMPOSING AN ANNUAL TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES ON EARNED INCOME RECEIVED AND NET PROFITS EARNED BY RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE AND NON-RESIDENTS WHO RECEIVE THE PRINCIPAL PART OF SUCH INCOME FROM EMPLOYMENT, BUSINESS OR OTHER ACTIVITY CONDUCTED WITHIN THE BOROUGH DURING THE PERIOD BEGINNING, JANUARY 1, 1970 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1970; REQUIRING THE FILING OF DECLARATIONS AND RETURNS AND GIVING OF INFORMATION BY EMPLOYERS AND BY THOSE SUBJECT TO THE TAX; IMPOSING ON EMPLOYERS THE DUTY OF COLLECTING THE TAX AT SOURCE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION, COLLECTION, ENFORCEMENT OF THE TAX; AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, in pursuance of authority granted to Boroughs by Act No. 511 of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania, approved the 31st day of December, 1965, A. D.

SECTION I

Ordinance No. 241 of 1969 providing for the levy and collection of an annual tax for general revenue purposes on earned income is hereby re-enacted and continued and the same tax of 1/2 of 1% is to continue the same at the same rate for the calendar year of 1970.
