

ORDINANCE NO. 253 of 1970

AN ORDINANCE RELOCATING SPRING ALLEY BY PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF SPRING ALLEY RELOCATED AND PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF THE EXISTING SPRING ALLEY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bentleyville and it is hereby ordained by and with the authority of the same.

ARTICLE I
OPENING OF A STREET

SECTION 1. Location- the alley is being opened for the benefit of the citizens of the Borough of Bentleyville and the public, in general, which extends from Lackawana Street to Penn Avenue and which is 14 feet in width and which runs along the southerly side of Lot #88 which is laid out in the W. F. Richardson Plan of Lots #2. The area used for this alley is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the westerly side of Lackawana Street, said point being common to lands of Clifford Jones, et ux, and George Ivicic, et ux; thence North $64^{\circ}40'$ West, 90 feet to a point on the eastwardly side of Penn Avenue; thence along Penn Avenue North $25^{\circ}20'$ East, 14 feet to a point; thence South $64^{\circ}40'$ East, 90 feet to a point on the westerly side of Lackawana Street; thence along Lackawana Street, South $25^{\circ}20'$ West, 14 feet to a point at the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. Name- the alley herein opened shall be known as Spring Alley.

VACATION

SECTION 1. The portion of Spring Alley hereinafter described is hereby vacated and closed as an existing alley in the Borough of
