

ORDINANCE NO. 361

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PERMITS TO MOVE INTO OR TO REMOVE FROM ANY HOUSE, DWELLING OR OTHER BUILDING WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE; PERMIT TO BE ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF THE BOROUGH WITHOUT CHARGE; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME, THAT:

SECTION 1. No person, firm or corporation shall move into or remove from, or cause his personal property to be so moved or removed from any house, dwelling or other building, within the Borough of Bentleyville, without first having obtained a permit therefor from the Secretary of the Borough of Bentleyville.

SECTION 2. Every person, firm or corporation seeking a permit to occupy any premises shall file an application with the Secretary of the Borough setting forth his name, location of the premises, name of owner, and his address, the nature of the proposed use of the building, and if for residence purposes, the name and ages of the occupants, and such permits be secured from the Secretary of the Borough of Bentleyville.

SECTION 3. Every person, firm or corporation seeking a permit to remove from any premises shall file an application with the Secretary of the Borough setting forth his name, address, the expected time of departure and furnish copies or proof thereof,
