

ORDINANCE NO. 371

An Ordinance accepting a part of the Fifty (50) foot wide street shown on the Subdivision Plan of the Bentleyville Apartments and recorded in Plan Book 19 page 139, and as described in the Deed of Dedication by the Bentleyville Associates dated February 3rd, 1984, and recorded in Deed Book 2141 page 57, as a public street in the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and to be names and known as Old West Road.

The Borough of Bentleyville hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The Borough of Bentleyville hereby accepts a part of the Fifty (50) foot wide street shown on the Subdivision Plan of the Bentleyville Apartments and recorded in Plan Book 19 page 139, and as described in the Deed of Dedication of the Bentleyville Associates dated February 3rd, 1984, and recorded in Deed Book 2141 page 57, as a public street in the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, said part of the 50 foot wide street which is accepted as a Borough street is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the easterly right of way line of State Highway # 62177, known as Beallsville Road 33 feet wide near St. Clements Roman Catholic Cemetery; thence along the north line of said 50 foot street, South $80^{\circ} 09' 38''$ East, 544.16 feet; thence along same, South $75^{\circ} 52' 20''$ East, 254.00 feet to a point; thence through other lands of Bentleyville Apartments by an arc of a circle curving right and having a radius of 43.00 feet an arc distance of 181.56 feet to a
